Purpose

It was more of a lecture event when Dr. Goth reviewed all the books. Currently various members of the group review books and everyone is encouraged to join in the discussion.

Priorities

- To make people feel welcome
- To provide a place where members are comfortable both reviewing books if that is their choice and joining in the discussion about these books

Activities

- Reviewing books
- Discussing books
- Visiting and eating
- For the congregation, the Book Club reports annually as part of Metropolitan's package of group reports to the annual congregational meeting.
- Yearly, at the first meeting of the new term the Book Club reviews this policy and select policies for which the group is responsible. If this policy is revised, it is then sent to the Board of Elders for approval.
